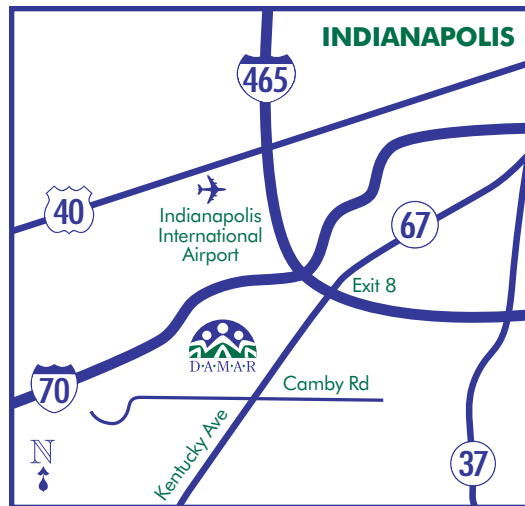

Damar serves the children and adults that most other organizations are unable to successfully serve – those with the most challenging emotional and behavioral issues. With an average of five and as many as 30 prior placements, these individuals are often referred to Damar for a last chance at success.

As the identification of autistic disorders has increased, the need for specialized services for these individuals and their families has also increased. Damar works with individuals and their families, helping them learn skills that increase self-sufficiency and greatly improve their quality of life.

At Damar, more than 90% of its residents achieve a greater level of independence. Success at Damar means more choice in daily living routines, opportunities for occupation and recreation, and strengthening family bonds. As socialization skills increase, integration and acceptance in the community opens new worlds of understanding to all in our society.

Damar provides 24-hour residential care for nearly two-hundred children with developmental disabilities. In addition, Damar provides a full continuum of support and therapeutic services to hundreds of children and adults with developmental disabilities living in the community.
